Missing the 'perfect' shot because they were enjoying the moment.



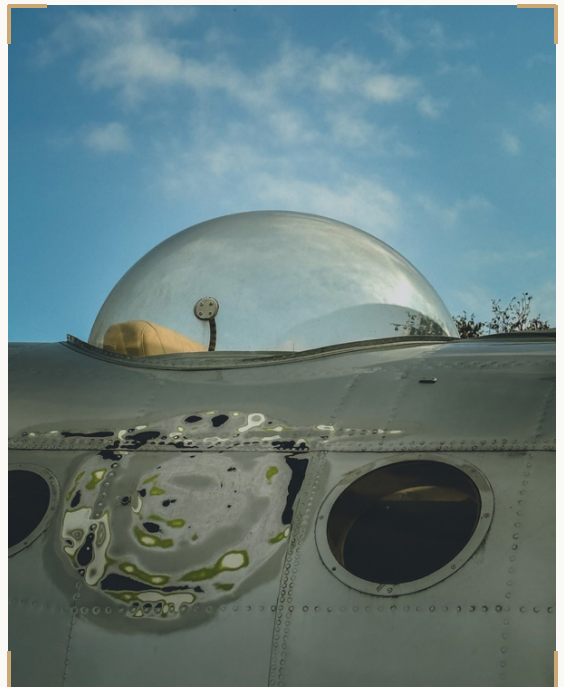
